I Charley Siddall of Number nine Pelham Street Carlton Melbourne, Victoria do hereby revoke all former wills and testamentary depositions made by me and declare this only to be my last will and Testament.

I appoint my brother Henry Siddall and brother-in-law Joseph Barker of Oak Hills, Upper Burdekin River Cardwell Queensland also F Bottomley, Draper Gertrude Street Fitzroy Melbourne and Thomas Benjamin Clay of Woodlands in New South Wales the Executors and trustees of this my will and I give to each of them for their trouble as Executors the sum of Fifty Pounds each

I give and bequeath to my wife Mary the sum of One hundred and four Pounds per annum. To be paid quarterly in advance for her natural life.

I direct my Executors and Trustees to pay one Pound per week for the maintenance of each child until such child shall attain twenty one years

If in the event of my estate proving favourable at a future time I empower my Executors and Trustees to advance to my wife, child, or children such sum or sums of money as they shall deem expedient for their position and future advancement in life

Upon my children attaining the age of Twenty one years I empower my executors and Trustees to dispose of all my real and personal estate (excepting such sum invested for paying my wife Mary's bequest) and divide the same equally between such lawful issue. Daughters Shares to be invested for their own use and their issue.

And I declare that any monies hereby directed to be invested may be invested in the names or name of my trustees or trustee in or upon any of the Public Funds or on Government or real or leasehold securities in England or the Australian Colonies or in or upon the Stocks, Shares, or securities of any Railway or other Public Company and such investments may be varied from time to time as my Trustees shall think fit
